

YAYSL MINUTES

October 8, 2008

John Breedlove, President, called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Communities present: Austintown, Beaver Local, Boardman, Canfield, Champion, Howland, Lakeview, Niles, Poland, Ravenna, Springfield and TCSC.

The following communities are in good standing are eligible to vote on YAYSL issues: Austintown, Boardman, Canfield, Howland, Lakeview, Niles, Poland, Springfield and Warren. Lakeview, Springfield and Warren must attend November's meeting to stay in good standing as their community has missed one meeting to date.

Minutes: The minutes for September 10th, 2008 were sent to all community representatives via e-mail. With no further discussions, John Breedlove asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Tom Brenneis (Poland) asked for a motion to approve the minutes for September 2008. Shawn Shaulis (Austintown) 2nd this motion. Motion accepted and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Heather stated that the balance in the checking account is \$21,731.12. Will need to pay for trophies, tournament referees, and miscellaneous tournament expenses, also host site and coaching class reimbursements.

OLD BUSINESS:

Goal Differential: A motion was made by Shawn Shaulis (Austintown) to change the wording for the goal differential in the tournament section of the Rules and Regulations, Article VIII, section K, #2b to: goal differential (goals scored less goals allowed, with maximum of four (4) goals scored per match) in head-to-head competition. Example: If team A scores 10 goals and team B scores 4 goals, the goal differential is 6 but only up to and including 4 goals will be used towards the standings. Tom Brenneis (Poland) 2nd this motion. Motion adopted and will be changed in the Rules and Regulations.

YAYSL Awards: Please send in your nominations for outstanding boys and girl's coach, referee, or anyone you feel that has done an outstanding job in the name of soccer for your community. Send a brief paragraph on why this person should be chosen to John Breedlove as soon as possible.

Fall Classic: Poland will host the U-14 and U15 teams at their new fields. Warren will host the U-12's and below. Thanks to these communities for allowing YAYSL to use their fields for the YAYSL's Fall Classic Tournament.

T.C. United Football Club: Mark Manning, Director of T.C. presented a quick review on this new club.
