

# **YAYSL MINUTES**

## **September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2008**

Frank Mancini, Vice President called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.

Communities present: Austintown, Beaver Local, Boardman, Canfield, Champion, Howland, Lakeview, Niles, Poland, Salem, Springfield, Warren, Campbell/Hubbard, and TCSC.

Minutes: The minutes for August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2008 were sent to all community's representatives via e-mail. With no discussion or corrections, Frank asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Shawn Shaulis (Austintown) made a motion to accept the minutes for August 13, 2008. Al Seman (Howland) 2<sup>nd</sup> this motion. Motion accepted and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Heather stated that the balance in the checkbook is \$10,297.85. Frank Mancini asked for a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Mike Arvin (Niles) made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Tom Brenneis (Poland) 2<sup>nd</sup> this motion. Treasurer's report accepted.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Fall Classic: Fees due at tonight's meeting. Fees are \$125.00 per team entered.

Ohio North's AGM: Will be held November 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> at the Kalahari Resort in Sandusky. You can make your reservations now. This AGM will have vendors, different coaching classes and much more. Please go to the states web site at [www.oysan.org](http://www.oysan.org) for more details. Also if you wish to nominate an outstanding boys coach or girls coach, a referee, an administrator or whomever, please go to the states web site, fill out the nomination form and submit to the state. This must be done before the end of September.

YAYSL Awards: If you wish to nominate an outstanding YAYSL coach, referee, administrator or someone that has been instrumental in your community in the name of soccer, please submit a letter explaining who and why, to John Breedlove at [jgeb1980@zoominternet.net](mailto:jgeb1980@zoominternet.net). This must be done no later than October 10<sup>th</sup>. Thanks.

Game Scores: Both coaches must submit their game scores to their age group score collector who will then submit them to Frank Mancini for posting on the web site. This should be done by Sunday night of each weekend's games. If Frank does not get a score of a game by the following weekend then those scores will be posted as a loss.

Games: If you play a team twice during the season, the score for the first game does not count towards the standings. If the first scheduled game was rescheduled to a later date it is still counted as the first time playing and will not count towards the standings.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Coaches' boxes: All fields should have coaches boxes lined out on their fields and coaches should stay within these boxes during games. Also, spectator lines should be marked on the fields.

Tournament Seeding: Since the Fall Classic is earlier this year it was discussed and agreed upon by all that for **seeding purposes only**, the standings as of October 12 will be used. This will enable the tournament committee to have a little more time to prepare the schedule and prepare for the tournament.

Tournament Locations: Poland and Warren have agreed to host this year's tournament. Poland will host the U-14's and up and Warren will host the U-12's and below. If there is a change with these locations you will be notified.

Goal differential in regular season: In order to alleviate the confusion, the goal differential language in Article IV, section D. #2 will change. The wording will be as follows "Goal differential; goals scored less goals allowed with maximum of 4 goals per match in head to head competition." Example: If team A scores 10 goals and team B scores 4 goals the goal differential is 6 but only up to and including 4 goals will be used towards the standings. This only affects games that count toward league standings. This language will be changed in the Rules and Regulations and then posted on the web site.

Indoor League: Niles new indoor facility will be opening sometime in November. Community reps: Please survey your coaches to see if any of your teams would be interested in forming/joining a YAYSL indoor league and bring those results to the next scheduled monthly meeting in October. Mike Arvin will check into the cost and present it at our next meeting. The field is 55 x 80 yards with a 40 foot ceiling and no walls. All FIFA rules apply except offsides.
