

YAYSL MONTHLY MINUTES

JULY 1, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Mike Arvin President.

Communities in attendance: Austintown, Beaver Local, Boardman, Canfield, Champion, Howland, Lakeview, Mathews, Niles, Poland, Springfield, Warren, West Branch, and Soccer Vision Academy.

Communities absent: Campbell, East Liverpool, Hubbard, LaBrae, Liberty, Ravenna, Salem, South Range, TCSC, and LaRama Unido Soccer Club.

Minutes: The minutes from June 10, 2009 we sent via e-mail to all community representatives. With no discussion, Mike Arvin asked for a motion to accept the minutes. Tom Brenneis (Poland) made a motion to accept June's minutes. Al Seman (Howland) 2nd this motion. Motion approved and minutes accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Heather stated that all bills have been paid and that a balance of \$20,145.23 is in checking. Mike Arvin asked for a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Tom Brenneis (Poland) made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Ken Learman (Soccer Vision Academy) 2nd this motion. Motion approved and treasurer's report accepted.

Report of Boards and Standing Committees:

- a) Executive Committee: Did not meet.
- b) Nominating Committee: Did not meet.
- c) Competition Committee: Did not meet.
- d) Coaching Committee: Scott MacMillan stated that the YES program will participated in the Stateline League. Emphasis will be placed on training. Tryouts will be by invitation only and probably be held in November. Team Managers must be selected and they need to realize that their responsibilities will involve time and dedication. Community Reps must submit names of qualified team managers to the secretary of YAYSL as soon as possible. Team managers will be in charge of paperwork to attending games. Trainers will be hired to train all teams. Training will take place at the Wellness Center early on Saturday or Sunday mornings. **More information will follow once team managers are selected. ***IT IS IMPORTANT FOR COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES TO SUBMIT NAMES OF QUALIFIED POTENTIAL TEAM MANAGERS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AS THIS WILL HELP STREAMLINE THE YES PROGRAM.** A soccer academy is in the works for younger players and as information becomes available it will be sent to all community representatives.
- e) Tournament Committee: Did not meet
- f) Referees Association Advisor: No information passed on to YAYSL.

Old/Unfinished Business:

Patches: Patches have been ordered. When they come in they will be passed out to all coaches.

Fees: Team fees are \$110.00 that is due at tonight's meeting along with Host Site/Team Declaration Form. Player/Coach fees, \$17.00. Fall Classic Fee, \$150.00 due at September's meeting.

Fall Registration: Registration will take place July 25th, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If your community did not sign up for a time slot at tonight's meeting, please contact the registrar, Joe Francis, mick075@aol.com for a registration time. If your community is using League One to register, you will need to bring, Risk Management approval forms, roster – original and 2 copies, coach/player passes with pictures attached. For new players bring copy of birth certificate, player membership forms - original and one copy. For new coaches bring coach registration form and of course Risk Management approval form. If your community is not using League One to register you will need to bring: Roster – original and two copies, player membership forms – original plus one copy, coaches registration form – original plus one copy, risk management approval form, copy of birth certificates for all new players, a copy of report card for all 14 year olds going into eighth grade this fall, plus player/coach passes. New Business:

League One User ID: If your community will be using League One to register teams and are in need of a User ID number please send to the secretary of YAYSL the following: Community name, a contact name with phone number and e-mail address.

Coaching Classes: The following coaching classes are being offered in our area: U-9/12 Coaching Module, July 17th and 18th at Boardman. U-9/12 Coaching Module, July 24 and 25th, Poland Township Hall next to Poland High School. D Coaches license, August 7th, 8th, and 9th and August 21st, 22nd, and 23rd, Wellness Center in Niles. If you are interested in any of the above classes you must go to the states website, www.oysan.org to register and pay for the classes. Scott MacMillan can put together a U-9/12 coaching module at the Wellness Center if need be. Please contact Scott for further information.

Reimbursements for Coaching Classes: The coaching classes fees have increased. After some discussion on reimbursements of fees, Tom Brenneis (Poland) made a motion for YAYSL to reimburse coaches up to \$110.00 for the U-9/12 coaching module and up to \$220.00 for the "D" coaching license. This motion was put to a vote with eligible communities voting. The vote passed unanimously by an 8 to 0 vote of being in favor of the increase in coaching class fee reimbursements. This increase of reimbursements will go into effect immediately for those taking classes this year. A coach must coach this fall after obtaining his/her license before being able to submit a request for reimbursement. A coach must also present a copy of his/her license when requesting to be reimbursed.

Adjournment: Al Seman (Howland) made a motion to adjourn tonight's meeting. Ken Learman (Soccer Vision Academy) 2nd the motion. Motion accepted. Meeting adjourned.

The next YAYSL meeting will be August 12th. This will also be the MANDATORY COACHES MEETING FOR ALL ROSTERED COACHES. The location will be announced at a later date.
