

YAYSL Monthly Minutes

June 10th, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:39 p.m. by Mike Arvin, President.

Communities in attendance: Austintown, Beaver Local, Canfield, Howland, Lakeview, Mathews, Niles, Poland, Springfield, TCSC, Warren, West Branch, Soccer Vision Academy, and LaRama Unido Soccer Club.

Communities absent: Boardman, Campell, Champion, East Liverpool, Hubbard, LaBrae, Liberty, Ravenna, Salem, and South Range.

Minutes: The minutes from May 13th, 2009 meeting were sent out to all communities via e-mail. Mike Arvin asked for a motion to approve the minutes. With no further discussion, Ken Learman (Soccer Vision Academy) made a motion to accept the minutes. Tom Brenneis (Poland) 2nd the motion. Motion approved and the minutes accepted.

Treasurer's report: Treasurer was absent but gave Mike a copy of the financial statement and made copies for all in attendance. The balance in checking is \$20,390.73. All bills have been paid. Mike Arvin asked for a motion to accept the financial statement. Al Seman (Howland) made a motion to accept the treasurer's financial statement. Frank Mancini (Canfield) 2nd this motion. Motion approved and the treasurer's financial statement was accepted.

Registrar's report: No report given.

Reports of Boards and Standing Committees:

- a. Executive Committee: Met on June 3rd. Discussed reimbursement of Spring League Bond money. Communities will have a choice of either applying the money to fall league fees or having it reimbursed to coaches. Also, discussed trophies. Frank will get quotes for trophies and report back to the executive committee.
- b. Nominating Committee: Did not meet.
- c. Competition Committee: Did not meet.
- d. Coaching Committee: Did not meet.
- e. Tournament Committee: Did not meet.
- f. Referee Association Advisor: Nothing reported to YAYSL.

Old/Unfinished Business:

Spring League Scores: All scores must be reported to Frank Mancini by June 30th, 2009. In order to receive your bond money you must play the mandatory 4 games.

Bond money: They Spring League Bond Money will be either applied to fall fees or reimbursed back to communities/coaches per their request. The bond will not be reimbursed to any community/coach that did not meet the mandatory 4 games played rule. No exceptions. The communities must present in writing, via e-mail, their choice of reimbursement either to the

secretary who will then forward it to the treasurer or to the treasurer, herself. No money will be issued until after June 30th, 2009.

Fall fees: Team fees are \$110.00 per team. Player/coach fees are \$17.00 per rostered player/coach. Tournament fees are \$150.00 per team.

Coaches list: Coaches list are due at tonight's meeting. If you did not submit one they should be sent to either the president or the secretary within a week of this meeting. Information required on list: Name of coach, address, home/cell phone, age division coaching in, and license level held.

New Business:

Coaches list: A second year and beyond coach must obtain a minimum of a U-9/U-12 coaching module license. For a list of courses, go to the states web site. All registration for these courses is done on-line on the states website.

July's meeting: The monthly YAYSL meeting for July is one week earlier. It will be July 1st, 2009, 7:30 p.m. at the Wellness Center. Please mark your calendars. You must bring your Host Site/Team Declaration Form in duplicate to July's meeting along with the team fees. Make checks payable to YAYSL.

Team Registration: Will be at the Wellness Center. It will be either July 18 or 25. The secretary will send out an e-mail when a date is confirmed. The following paperwork is required for registration: (1) Roster-original plus 2 copies. (2) Player Membership Form-original plus 1 copy (the new one that is on the YAYSL's website). (3) Coach Registration Form-original plus one copy. Please attach you approved Risk Management to your **COPY** of the coach membership form. (4) A copy of a Birth Certificate for all new players. (5) A copy of report cards for any player that is already 14 years of age and going into 8th grade this fall. (6) Player/Coach passes. Must be filled out correctly and an updated picture is attached. Medical forms are not needed at registration, but if you plan on participating in tournaments your medical forms should be notarized. ***** Don't forget to put team numbers on all forms. A list of team numbers will be sent out to all community reps shortly after this meeting and a list of community prefix numbers will also be sent out. Season begins: The fall 2009 season will begin the weekend of August 29th and 30th.

Bothwell Tournament: YAYSL will be sending 4 first place teams, U-13's and U-14's boys and girls, to the Bothwell Tournament. After some discussion on how to determine first place teams, since the season will be just starting and the entry deadline for Bothwell is in September, it was agreed to table this discussion to next months meeting.
