

Spring League Registration Guidelines

Every team must have at least (1) registered coach. Any person who coaches must be registered as a coach with that team and complete the Risk Management (RM) form. The RM form must be submitted to the state office via the online Risk Management (RM) form at www.oysan.org.

All registration information must be completed to finalize registration information. If all information is not complete with appropriate copies and information, registration will not be completed. If you are unclear of the requirements for spring league play, you must contact the leagues registrar, Joe Francis, at mick075@aol.com prior to the registration date. All forms required for registration can be found on the YAYSL's website under Registration/Forms.

- An excel spreadsheet must be sent to the registrar, Joe Francis, mick075@aol.com prior to registration, listing only the **NEW** players and **NEW** coaches information.
- Rosters must be filled out completely (Original plus one copy). Whiteout player's names that are not participating in spring league and add new players names. If your team from the fall changes by more than 50% plus one, then you must follow the registration process as if you were a new team.
- Each new player must have a copy of their birth certificate and player membership form (Original plus one copy) present at registration.
- Player/coach passes must be filled out completely with picture and player signature.
- Risk Management (RM) must be filed online at time of registration. New coaches must also have a coach registration form present at registration. (Original plus one copy)

The following changes are for Spring League Registration only:

Team, Player, Coach Fees:

Team: \$175.00 for each Team U-10 and Up. (\$100.00 is a refundable bond to ensure that the minimum 4 games are completed) Checks made payable to: YAYSL.

Coach/Player: \$12.00 for each Rostered Coach and Player not registered with YAYSL in previous fall season. (These fees are due at Spring Registration) Checks made payable to: YAYSL.

Transfer Fees: \$5.00 for each player that is transferred from another team. If a player was registered during the previous fall season and they are transferred to another team a player transfer form must be filled out. Checks made payable to YAYSL.

Referee Fees: \$15.00 for U-10. \$20.00 for U-11/U-12. \$24.00 for U-13 to U-19. Each team is required to bring one-half of the amount stated. **ONLY ONE REFEREE IS REQUIRED FOR SPRING LEAGUE PLAY.**

PLAYER PASSCARD INSTRUCTIONS

Each member entering interstate competition must carry the US Youth Soccer member passcard. The pass identifies the member by recent photo and by signature and is proof of registration and Eligibility. It should be typed, printed by computer or neatly printed.

The left (white) and the right (blue-membership) sides of the pass should contain the following Information:

Front of Member Pass (White):

STATE: Name of National State Youth Association (*Ohio North or OYSAN*)

MEMBER: Type of member (*player, coach, assistant coach or team manager*)

NAME: Name of member

BIRTH DATE: Month/day/year of the player. It is not necessary to indicate a coach's birth date on the front of the card.

TEAM: Team name

TEAM NUMBER: Unique number assigned to team

AGE GROUP: Appropriate age group (intent is team age group)

SEASONAL YEAR: Indicates current seasonal year (*2005-2006*)

LD/#: Identification Number: This may be league or State-generated #

Back of Member Pass:

Left side: A small recent passport-style pot of the player (approximately 1" x 1") should be glued to the upper left corner where it indicates "attach photo here".

The member should sign in cursive (except for the very young player) on the lone indicating player signature. This signature must be as the name appears on the front of the card and the team roster.

Directly below the member's signature, the pass must be signed by the appropriate registrar on the line indicating registrar signature. This individual is verifying the registration with the National State Association.

Right side: This membership card, indicating the code of conduct, should be given to the member.

It is recommended that all passes be laminated.
